Terms

- In order to adequately set-up before registration opens, you *must* promptly arrive at camp by 1 p.m. to unload our gear truck. Move into your cabin and be <u>ready to</u> work by 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, July 3. If you do not keep this commitment you will have failed to complete your Work-Trade and will not be eligible for the work trade discount.
- 2) Meet with your Crew Manager at the Camp House (near the registration table) promptly at 2:00 p.m. to receive your set-up assignments. We have much to prepare before campers begin arriving at 4:00 p.m.
- 3) You *must* help clean and close camp on Saturday, July 10. With another camp arriving at our heels, we *must* vacate the facility by no later than **12noon**.
- 4) During camp, your primary daily tasks will focus on cleaning and maintaining the bathhouses, taking approximately one to two hours per day. Additional chores may include occasionally moving tables & benches, replenishing bottled water dispensers, and hanging/striking decorations.
- 5) Please be sure to bring an alarm clock (don't worry, no 6:00am wake-up calls), a flashlight, sturdy walking shoes and a great attitude.
