

1.	Head south on Cloister Ln/Redwood Dr to Cathedral Dr	0.1 mi
➔ 2.	Slight right at Cathedral Dr	0.2 mi
➔ 3.	Turn right to stay on Cathedral Dr	1.1 mi 3 mins
➔ 4.	Turn right at Trout Gulch Rd	0.1 mi
➔ 5.	Turn right at Soquel Dr	0.6 mi 2 mins
← 6.	Turn left at State Park Dr	361 ft
7.	Merge onto CA-1 N via the ramp to Santa Cruz	6.2 mi 6 mins
8.	Take the exit onto CA-17 N toward Oakland/San Jose	26.5 mi 30 mins
9.	Continue on I-880 N	26.7 mi 22 mins
10.	Take the CA-92/Jackson St exit	0.4 mi
11.	Merge onto CA-92 E	1.7 mi 4 mins
12.	Continue on E St	0.4 mi 1 min
← 13.	Turn left at 2nd St	0.3 mi 2 mins
➔ 14.	Turn right at B St Continue up B Street .8 mi	0.8 mi 2 mins

The Hill and Valley Club is on your LEFT at the corner of B Street and Linden Street, just before the First Church of Hayward. Turn LEFT on Linden Street to park behind the hall in the parking lot, on the street, or in the Church parking lot.


