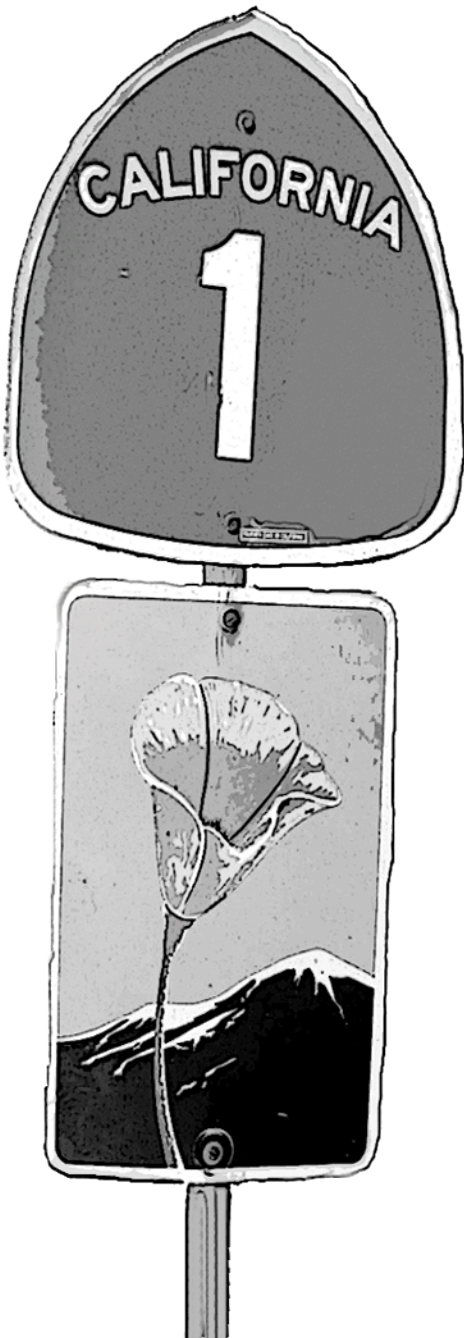


Fall Dance Weekend
