PERSONS OF QUALITY is comprised of three talented musicians performing English country dance music with enthusiasm, driving rhythm and imagination, playing a wide array of instruments: **Jon Berger**, traditional fiddler par excellence; **Jim Oakden**, accomplished player of an absurd number of instruments; pianist **Rebecca King**, whose classical and jazz training shows in her rhythmic and lyrical accompaniments.

FINE COMPANIONS, a group of highly accomplished Northwest musicians, features dreamy textures, rich harmonies and rhythmic excitement: Fiddler **Betsy Branch**, a pillar of the Portland, Oregon dance community for many years; **Bill Tomzcak**, clarinet, saxophone and percussion, renowned improviser in many international folk styles; **Erik Weberg** on flute, highly regarded musician and caller at dances, dance camps and balls throughout the country; **Mark Douglass**, who infuses gospel, swing, jazz and blues into his dance piano playing.

Kalia Kliban has demonstrated her mastery of folk dance and teaching in the Bay area and nationwide since the 1980's.

David Millstone, from New Hampshire, is one of the nation's leading traditional dance experts and historians.

Facilities and Accommodations

The Mt Hood Kiwanis Camp, one hour east of Portland and near Rhododendron, OR, features a large wooden dance floor in the main lodge, comfortable spaces for workshops and jamming, and bunk-style accommodations in heated rooms or cabins. Registration is \$20 less for those who stay onsite in a tent or camper van (space permitting), or in offsite lodging.
